1. Who we are

2. Information we collect

Account details you submit, such as name and email, when you create a member login or enter a contest. Editorial correspondence sent to desk@aperturematrix.com, community@aperturematrix.com, press@aperturematrix.com, or advertise@aperturematrix.com. Technical data created by your browser, including pages viewed, device type, and approximate location derived from IP address. Bookmarks and preferences stored in your browser for this static edition.

3. How we use information

We use information to publish and improve Aperture Matrix, to moderate community features, to run photography contests, to respond to license and press requests, and to protect photographs and editorial work from unauthorized copying. We do not sell personal information.

4. Photographs and watermarks

Images on Aperture Matrix carry a visible watermark and are owned by Aperture Matrix Publishing LLC unless a community author is credited. Watermarks, disabled image dragging, and similar measures are used to discourage unauthorized downloads. They do not replace copyright. License requests must be sent to the editorial desk.

5. Cookies and local storage

This edition may store a member name, theme preference, bookmarks, and publisher drafts in your browser. You can clear that data at any time through your browser settings. Third-party embeds, such as YouTube videos, may set their own cookies under their policies.

6. Sharing

We share information only with service providers who help us operate the site, when required by law, or with your consent. Contest entries may be displayed publicly with the name you provide.

7. Retention and security

We keep information only as long as needed for the purposes above or as required by law. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure. Do not send payment card numbers to the magazine email addresses.
